



Can I Vote?



The State of Colorado holds regularly scheduled state elections every two years; a state Primary election in June and a General election in November.

Colorado permits online voter registration, early voting, and a vote-by-mail option for all elections.

If you are voting by mail, your ballot must be RECEIVED by the clerk on or before election day.

You can register and vote on the same day as the election at a Voter Service and Polling Center.

If voting in person, voters in Colorado are required to present a valid form of identification at the polls.

In order to vote in the Primary you must be affiliated with a political party that has a candidate on the ballot. If you are registered but not affiliated with a political party you may choose a party at any time before and through the day of the primary election to vote in the primary.

Important 2016 dates

TO VOTE IN THE PRIMARY ELECTION

May 27, 2016 Last day to switch party affiliation to vote in the primary.

June 6, 2016 Last day to register through a voter registration drive.

June 20, 2016 Last day to register to vote and still receive a ballot in the mail.

June 28, 2016 Colorado Primary Election (Polls open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.)

TO VOTE IN THE GENERAL ELECTION

October 17, 2016 Last day to register through a voter registration drive.

October 31, 2016 Last day to register to vote and still receive a ballot in the mail.

November 8, 2016 Colorado General Election (Polls open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.)
