KNOW THE LAW!

The belief that individuals lose their right to vote due to a past criminal conviction in Colorado is <u>NOT</u> true.

YOU CAN VOTE IN COLORADO IF

- You are on pretrial detention or on bond/summons.
- You are currently serving a jail sentence for a misdemeanor.
- You are on probation for a felony or misdemeanor conviction.
- If you are on a direct sentence or on parole while at a halfway house, you are eligible to vote.
- You are on parole after release from state prison. (New law passed in 2019)
- You are on federal supervised release after being released from federal prison.
